

Stilts Training Kit

The Stilts Training Kit is housed at Cottenham Village College as part of the stART equipment bank and is available to hire by school and community groups across South Cambridgeshire. The Stilt Training kit includes:

- 7 pairs of 40cm metal stilts
- 4 pairs of 40cm wooden stilts
- 3 pairs of 80cm metal stilts
- 2 pairs of 100cm metal stilts
- 16 pairs of knee pads
- 20 sets of vecro straps
- 2 portable crash mats

Terms and Conditions of Hire

Risk, ownership and insurance

- The kit may only be hired by individuals or organisations who have received training or instruction on how to safely use stilts.
- stART accepts no liability for loss, damage, injury or claims caused by, or contributed to by the hirers use of the stilt kit or any part of it.
- stART cannot offer insurance to cover use of the stilts kit or any part of it. It is the responsibility of the individual or organisation hiring the kit to ensure that appropriate insurances are in place to cover their activity.
- Risk in the hire of the stilts kit will pass immediately to the hirer when the items are collected, and remain with the hirer for the duration of the hire period. (This shall apply even if there is no hire fee charged to the hirer.)
- Ownership of the goods shall remain at all times with stART, and the hirer must not lend or re-hire the kit to a third party without written agreement with stART.

Collection and care of goods

- It is the responsibility of the hirer to collect and return the items to Cottenham Village College at a time to be agreed with the local Arts Development Manager.
- The hirer should notify the local Arts Development Manager immediately regarding any loss or damage to the kit, or if they have any concerns about the condition of the kit.
- The hirer is expected to look after the kit and ensure it is not left unattended in a public place.

Availability and payment

- The kit will be booked on a first come first serve basis with priority given to clubs and organisations working with on a project supported by stART.
- Fee for hire of the kit is negotiable depending on duration and nature of the project. Please contact the local Arts Development Manager to agree details.
